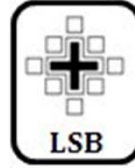

Features of the Hymnal Concordance

- **Concordance:** A concordance is an alphabetical index of all the words in a writing or collection of writings, showing every occurrence of each word in the context of the phrase in which the word appears.
- **Hymnal Concordance:** A hymnal concordance indexes all the words in the text of the hymn stanzas (lyrics) and hymn titles. Our concordance provides a separate index for each of the seven Lutheran hymnals, each purchased as a separate product.
- **Words Linked to Phrases:** Each word in the concordance is accessed by first clicking on a letter of the alphabet, and then clicking on the desired word from a list. A list of phrases is displayed for each word with a reference tag.
- **References:** A reference tag in the form 'HYMN.STANZA.PHRASE' (e.g. 123.1.2) precedes each phrase, where HYMN is the hymn number, STANZA is the stanza number, and PHRASE is the phrase within the stanza containing the word.
- **Lyrics:** Clicking on the reference tag will display thumbnail images of the hymn lyrics, one image per stanza showing the context of the phrase within the hymn.

Installation

- **ZIP install:** If your concordance was delivered in a ZIP file, unzip the contents of the zip file to any folder on your hard disk, then click the file *index.html* to open the concordance in your browser. The concordance will not function if the files are opened directly from the ZIP file.
- **CD/DVD install:** If your concordance was delivered on a CD or DVD, insert the disk into your drive and Windows will automatically open the concordance in your browser; alternatively, click the file *index.html* to open the concordance.
- **Online:** If you purchased online access for your concordance, there is no installation required; simply use your browser to access the concordance on the web.
- **Hard Disk install:** You may copy the files onto your hard disk for convenient access and faster response; copy all the files and the entire folder structure intact.
- **Uninstall:** The concordance may be uninstalled by simply deleting all the files.
- Depending on how your specific purchase is packaged and delivered, some of these installation methods may not apply to your purchase.

System Requirements

- The concordance is a browser-based reference. Use *Internet Explorer* or *Firefox* on Windows to access the concordance; use *Safari* on Macintosh and iPad.
- The *Abridged Concordance* is a printer-friendly subset of the browser-based unabridged concordance which focuses on significant words. A .pdf file containing the *Abridged Concordance* may be found in the root folder of the concordance installation.
- *Adobe Reader* is required to view the *Abridged Concordance* PDF file.
