## Features of the Large Print Library

- **Intended Usage:** Large print hymn sheets with the hymn melody and lyrics are ideal for children or assisting sight-impaired worshipers in reading hymns.
- **Content:** One PDF file is provided for each hymn. Each file contains the hymn's melody and lyrics approximately two times the size printed in the standard pew hymnal. The hymns are oriented in landscape format to maximize readability and minimize the number of page turns required.
- **PDF Format:** The hymns are provided in PDF format, a widely used format for storing high quality files (.pdf). The format is viewed and printed using *Adobe Reader*.
- **Printing:** The PDF files can be printed using *Adobe Reader* and will produce excellent results when printed on a high quality printer. One recommended usage is to print selected hymn sheets for a single worship service and place the hymn sheets into a 3-ring binder for easy handling during the worship service.

## Installation (Download)

- **PDF:** If your library was delivered as a download, the download is a large PDF file containing all the large print hymns. No installation is required, simply use *Adobe Reader* to view and print the hymn sheets as desired.
- **Uninstall:** The library may be uninstalled by simply deleting the PDF file.

## Installation (Mail Order)

- **CD/DVD install:** If your library was delivered on a CD or DVD, insert the disk into your drive and Windows will automatically open the library in your browser; alternatively, click the file *index.html* to open the library.
- **USB install:** If your library was delivered on a USB drive, insert the drive into a USB port and click the file *index.html* in the root folder to open the library in your browser.
- **Hard Disk install:** You may copy the files onto your hard disk for convenient access and faster response; copy all the files and the entire folder structure intact.
- **PDF Access:** You may access each hymn's PDF directly by opening the *largeprint* folder inside the root folder of your installation.
- **Uninstall:** The library may be uninstalled by simply deleting all the files.
- Depending on how your specific purchase is packaged and delivered, some of these installation methods may not apply to your purchase.

- Use *Internet Explorer* or *Firefox* browsers on Windows; use *Safari* on Macintosh and iPad.
- *Adobe Reader* is required to view and print PDF files.
