Features of the Midi Library

- **Overview:** This MP3 library provides sound files performed on a brilliant-sounding cathedral pipe organ with stanza repeats matching the hymnal stanzas.
- **MP3 Format:** The music files in this library are "MP3" files (MPEG-1 Audio Layer 3, .mp3), which is a digital audio encoding format common for consumer audio storage, as well as a standard encoding for the transfer and playback of music on digital audio players.
- **Player Software:** MP3 player software must be installed on your computer in order to listen to MP3 files on your sound card and speakers. If you surf the web regularly for music files, you probably already have a MP3 player installed on your computer.
- **Player Devices:** Many electronic players, such as the Apple iPod, can play MP3 files that are loaded into the memory/storage of the device.
- **Sound Quality:** In the absence of a trained organist, many congregations use our MP3 files to lead worship service hymn singing and find the quality acceptable when the MP3s are played using a good sound system.

Installation

- **CD/DVD install:** If your library was delivered on a CD or DVD, insert the disk into your drive and Windows will automatically open the library in your browser; alternatively, click the file *index.html* to open the library.
- **USB install:** If your library was delivered on a USB drive, insert the drive into a USB port and click the file *index.html* in the root folder to open the library in your browser.
- **Online:** If you purchased online access for your library, there is no installation required; simply use your browser to access the media content on the web.
- **Hard Disk install:** You may copy the files onto your hard disk for convenient access and faster response; copy all the files and the entire folder structure intact.
- **Media access:** Direct access to the individual MP3 files is supported by directly opening the *mp3* folder inside the root folder of each hymnal's installation.
- **Uninstall:** The library may be uninstalled by simply deleting all the files.
- Depending on how your specific purchase is packaged and delivered, some of these installation methods may not apply to your purchase.

System Requirements

- Use *Internet Explorer* or *Firefox* browsers on Windows; use *Safari* on Macintosh and iPad.
- MP3 player software is required to play the MP3 files on your computer; free players include Apple's *QuickTime* and Microsoft's *Windows Media Player*.
- Browse our web store to determine disk space requirements for each product.
