Features of the Multi-Media Library

- **Video:** The Video Library provides 'Sing-Along' hymn videos with lyrics synchronized with the music. Full screen display is provided using *Adobe Flash Player*, *Windows Media Player*, or an MP4 player such as *QuickTime*. Videos are intended for small group singing, congregation worship, or personal enjoyment.
- **MP3:** High quality MP3 sound files (.mp3) played on a brilliant-sounding cathedral pipe organ playable with MP3 player software or an MP3 device.
- **Midi:** Midi sound files contain melody and harmony chords (.mid). Full SATB settings as found in the hymnal are not included in the midi files due to copyright restrictions.
- **Sheet Music:** Hymn sheet music (.pdf) with melody, lyrics, and piano/guitar chords. Melodies are provided for instruments in the keys of C (hymnal key), Bb, and Eb.
- **Large Print:** Large print hymn sheets (.pdf) with melody and lyrics approximately two times the size printed in the pew hymnal. Ideal for assisting sight-impaired worshipers.
- **PowerPoint:** Fully editable PowerPoint files (.ppt) containing hymn lyrics, one stanza per slide. Useful in small groups or worship services to project hymn lyrics on a large screen.
- **Slides:** Browser-based slideshow viewer with stanza lyrics on projectable JPEG slides; full screen resolution using the slide viewer (.jpg).
- **Text:** Hymn stanza lyrics in text format (.txt). Cut & Paste the lyrics text into bulletins and handouts as desired.
- **Concordance:** Unabridged hymnal concordance indexing every word in the hymn lyrics.

Installation

- **ZIP install:** If your library was delivered in a ZIP file, unzip the contents of the zip file to any folder on your hard disk, then click the file *index.html* to open the library in your browser. The library will not function if the files are opened directly from the ZIP file.
- **CD/DVD install:** If your library was delivered on a CD or DVD, insert the disk into your drive and Windows will automatically open the library in your browser; alternatively, click the file *index.html* to open the library in your browser.
- **USB install:** If your library was delivered on a USB drive, insert the drive into a USB port and click the file *index.html* in the root folder to open the library in your browser.
- **Online:** If you purchased online access for your library, there is no installation required; simply use your browser to access the media content on the web.
- **Hard Disk install:** You may copy the files onto your hard disk for convenient access and faster response; copy all the files and the entire folder structure intact.
- **Media access:** Direct access to the media files (video, slide, sheet music, PowerPoint, midi, (ASCII) text, and MP3) is supported by directly opening the media folders inside the root folder of each hymnal's installation.
- **Uninstall:** The library may be uninstalled by simply deleting all the files.
- Depending on how your specific purchase is packaged and delivered, some of these installation methods may not apply to your purchase.

System Requirements

- Use *Internet Explorer* or *Firefox* browsers on Windows; use *Safari* on Macintosh and iPad.
- *Adobe Flash Player* and *Adobe Reader* are required to view flash videos and PDF files.
- Microsoft *Windows Media Player* is required to play the WMV format videos.
- An MP4 player, such as Apple's *QuickTime* player, is required to play MP4 videos.
- MP3 and midi player software is required to play the .mp3 and .mid format music files.
- Microsoft *PowerPoint* software is required to open and edit the PowerPoint lyrics files.
- Any text editor can open and edit the ASCII text lyrics files.
