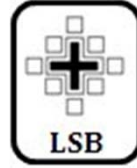

Features of the PowerPoint Library

- **Intended Usage:** The PowerPoint Library is intended for large screen projection of hymn lyrics during small group gatherings or worship services.
- **Format:** The presentation files in this library are provided in PowerPoint format, a widely used proprietary format developed by Microsoft (.ppt). The format used is compatible with PowerPoint 2003 and later versions.
- **Content:** One PowerPoint file is provided for each hymn. Each file contains a title slide, multiple slides containing the lyrics of the hymn stanzas, and an ending credits slide.
- **Editing:** The PowerPoint files are fully editable using Microsoft's PowerPoint software. The background picture may be replaced, slides may be added or deleted, and individual stanzas of text may be modified. The slide transition style between slides may also be edited, if desired.

Installation

- **ZIP install:** If your library was delivered in a ZIP file, unzip the contents of the zip file to any folder on your hard disk, then click the file *index.html* to open the library in your browser. The library will not function if the files are opened directly from the ZIP file.
- **CD/DVD install:** If your library was delivered on a CD or DVD, insert the disk into your drive and Windows will automatically open the library in your browser; alternatively, click the file *index.html* to open the library.
- **USB install:** If your library was delivered on a USB drive, insert the drive into a USB port and click the file *index.html* in the root folder to open the library in your browser.
- **Online:** If you purchased online access for your library, there is no installation required; simply use your browser to access the media content on the web.
- **Hard Disk install:** You may copy the files onto your hard disk for convenient access and faster response; copy all the files and the entire folder structure intact.
- **Media access:** Direct access to the PowerPoint files is supported by directly opening the *powerpoint* folder inside the root folder of each hymnal's installation.
- **Uninstall:** The library may be uninstalled by simply deleting all the files.
- Depending on how your specific purchase is packaged and delivered, some of these installation methods may not apply to your purchase.

System Requirements

- Use *Internet Explorer* or *Firefox* browsers on Windows; use *Safari* on Macintosh and iPad.
- Microsoft *PowerPoint* software is required to view and edit the PowerPoint files.
