## Features of the Video Library

- **Intended Use:** The Video Library provides 'Sing-Along' videos featuring lyrics synchronized with the hymn music. Videos are intended for small group singing, congregation worship, or personal enjoyment.
- **Video:** The video displays the hymn lyrics in a reverent, scrolling manner. Words are highlighted in synchronization with the hymn music sound track. The video background images depict religious and soothing nature scenes that vary by hymn.
- **Sound:** Each video's sound track features a brilliant-sounding cathedral pipe organ which is embedded in each hymn video. Each video begins with a short musical introduction, followed by the stanzas, and concludes with an appropriate 'Amen'.

## Video Formats

- **Formats:** Three different video formats are provided in the Video Library: Flash, Windows Media Video and MPEG-4, each providing high resolution, full screen video.
- **Flash:** Adobe Flash format (.swf) is a web standard playable inside most web browsers using the *Adobe Flash Player* plug-in.
- **WMV:** Windows Media Video (.wmv) is Microsoft's standard video format and is played using Microsoft's *Windows Media Player*.
- **MP4 Format:** MP4 format (.mp4) is the MPEG-4 (Motion Picture Expert Group 4) standard for video. MP4 files can be played on a variety of players, including Apple's *QuickTime* player.

## Installation

- **CD/DVD install:** If your library was delivered on a CD or DVD, insert the disk into your drive and Windows will automatically open the library in your browser; alternatively, click the file *index.html* to open the library in your browser.
- **USB install:** If your library was delivered on a USB drive, insert the drive into a USB port and click the file *index.html* in the root folder to open the library in your browser.
- **Online:** If you purchased online access for your library, there is no installation required; simply use your browser to access the media content on the web.
- **Hard Disk install:** You may copy the files onto your hard disk for convenient access and faster response; copy all the files and the entire folder structure intact.
- **Media access:** Direct access to the video files is supported by directly opening the *swf*, *mp4*, or *wmv* folders inside the root folder of each hymnal's installation.
- **Uninstall:** The library may be uninstalled by simply deleting all the files.
- Depending on how your specific purchase is packaged and delivered, some of these installation methods may not apply to your purchase.

## System Requirements

- Use *Internet Explorer* or *Firefox* browsers on Windows; use *Safari* on Macintosh and iPad.
- *Adobe Flash Player* is required to play flash videos.
- Microsoft's *Windows Media Player* is required to play the WMV format videos.
- An MP4 player, such as Apple's *QuickTime* player, is required to play MP4 videos.
